Five Day Training

Synopsis: This five day session provides coaches with the knowledge of how provide guidance and professional development for their teachers in writing instruction in order to meet the demands of the Common Core State Standards in Writing.

Target Audience: Instructional Coaches

Goals:

- To provide training in writing instruction for coaches that can be taken back to their individual schools to enhance writing instruction in all classrooms.
- To provide training in what the CCSS in Writing are and offer specific ideas for how to help teachers implement instruction that supports the CCSS in Writing.
- To provide opportunities for coaches to broaden their understanding of writing research, writing best practices, and the use of culturally relevant mentor text.

Outcomes:

- Greater understanding of what good writing instruction looks like and how to create and support it in classrooms across the grade levels.
- Understand how to use culturally relevant writing as mentor text to create student engagement.
- Write original pieces that can be used as mentor text in training sessions.
- Increase coaches' own comfort level with writing and their ability to share their writing with their teachers and model it in classroom settings.
